

Hello Coaches and Athletes:

The following psych sheet posting of the 5A State Swim and Dive Meet is UNOFFICIAL and will remain so at least until the conclusion of the 5A coaches meeting Wednesday Nov. 4.

COMMENTS IN REGARDS TO THIS POSTING:

- 1.) This psych sheet post is unofficial at this time.
- 2.) This psych sheet reflects the region champs plus the fastest region finals swims to make a field of 24.
- 3.) Region champs have been accounted for and if adjustments were made they are noted in the right hand margin.
- 4.) Ties which need to be resolved are also noted in the right hand margin.
- 5.) Please carefully review the psych sheet and if you see or have any concerns or discrepancies, please e-mail them to [tournaments@aiaonline.org](mailto:tournaments@aiaonline.org).
- 6.) If your athlete does not have the "SR, JR, SO, FR" designation associated with their name, please e-mail that information to [tournaments@aiaonline.org](mailto:tournaments@aiaonline.org). Make sure to include athlete, team, coach, contact info, etc...

COACHES:

- 1.) If you have qualified relays in the state meet you must declare your relay swimmers (including alternates) by Tuesday Nov. 3 at 6:00pm. The relay names you declared for your region meet will not be carried over to the state meet. All relay name declarations/entries must be made through Direct Athletics by Tuesday Nov. 3 at 6:00pm. Please do not declare relay names if your relay did not qualify for the state meet. COACHES, when in Direct Athletics, make sure you choose relays and not individuals as you declare your relay names. COACHES, when you have completed your declarations/entries, make sure you select "update". Also, there are two options for retaining a Direct Athletics receipt. The options should appear once you press update. You may opt to have the system print you a receipt, or you may opt to have the system e-mail you one; I, recommend both. You must retain one or both of these receipts. We cannot accept a computer screen print or any other type of printout as an entry receipt. Remember, Girls and Boys are treated as separate teams in Direct Athletics. You must enter them separately and get receipts for them separately.
- 2.) Please plan on having a representative from your coaching staff attend the coaches meeting this Wednesday Nov. 4. The meeting will take place at 7:00 pm at the AIA office.
- 3.) Please make sure you are familiar with the NFHS rulebook.
- 4.) Please make sure you have printed and read the State Swim and Dive Tournament Guide and that you meet all deadlines and protocols (Swim Entries, Dive Entries, Team and Credential Info).
- 5.) Please refer to the dive entry section of the state tournament guide as DIVE ENTRY DEADLINES ARE QUICKLY APPROACHING.
